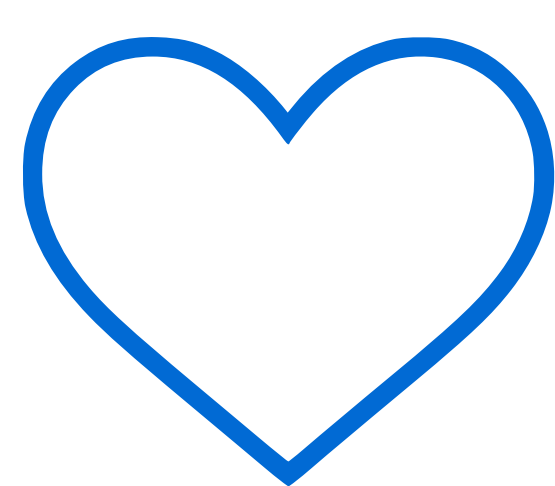

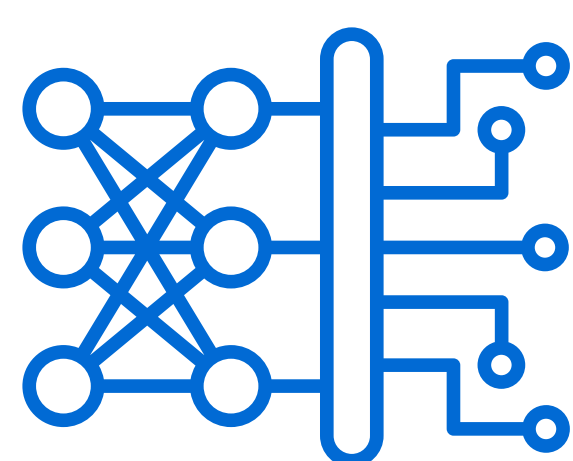

“ Sexual Exploration

For Profit

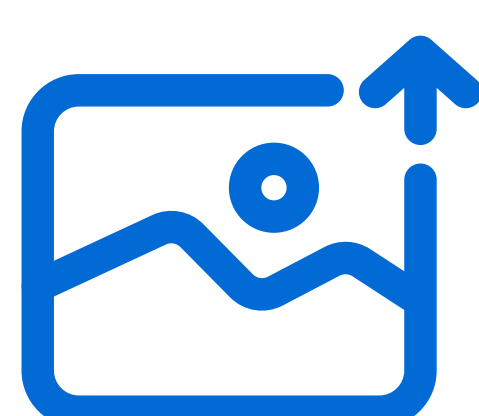
I don't have to pay someone to take photos of me in my underwear.

Anti-Censorship

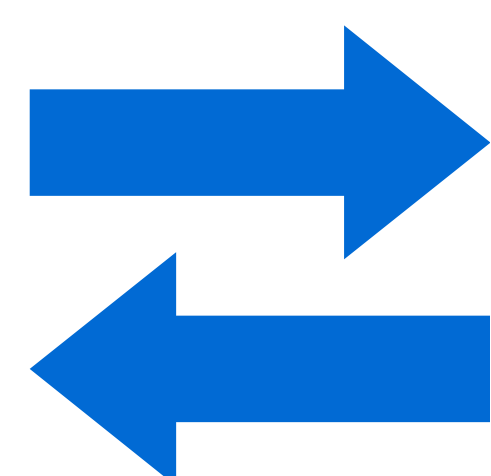
What I enjoyed the most? Sharing knowledge... And also helping break big AI company Terms of Service.

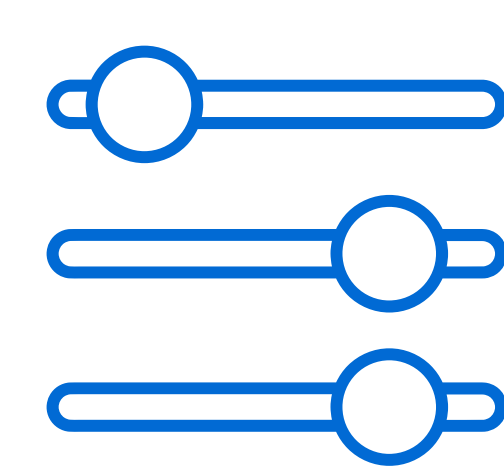
